We had water damage from a water heater upstairs back in September of last year. Our whole downstairs was covered in water. When we got home, it looked like waterfalls from all the light fixtures over the kitchen. Chaos.

After the initial shock of it all, we began the work to see what we needed to do. I called the insurance company, then contractors, then back to insurance and thought we had a

I went on Thursday evening and picked a few I liked and for the one I wanted, there wasn't a sample available. I thought we could look at the choices Kristin made and we could make a decision. It feels like a big decision. One floor to last for years and create memories on, eating meals and hosting friends. When the samples came in we laid them all out and took a look. We both almost immediately knew which one we liked best. It turned out to be the sample that I couldn't get. She had chosen the exact one I was looking for. The choice was easy because we were both on the same page, we knew what we were looking for because we had spent so much time thinking and talking about it.

Searching for a floor, in reality, is an important decision but it is not a big decision. Our church has before us some big decisions to make and I am counting on God to help us make this pastor search transition in unity and humility. As I watched our floors coming out, it revealed the old glue and concrete below. But I was filled with excitement because something new is on the way. Isaiah 43:19 says, "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland." (NIV) God is going to do a new thing in our midst and we need to spend time together in prayer. We must cover our church and equip our church to pray for God to move in incredible ways in this season. We must pray that he brings us together in unity (John 17) and humility by embodying the words from Philippians 2:1-2 "Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being likeminded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind."
