Now I know there are multiple ones around, not just on our campus but around town. So ... be on the lookout for Jesus. I hope you see one of these because they will bring a smile to your face, but I hope when you see one that you are reminded that Jesus is with you. He is with us. He wants to see you smile this week and be reminded that He is at work in your life and the world around you. I pray that you may be reminded of this truth, For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to offer his life as a ransom for many. (Mark 10:45)

I want to encourage you to be Jesus to the people you encounter every day. In the same way that I hope you find a holy interruption this week, may you be that holy interruption to someone else. If a person you know needs prayer, or a meal, or a hug, be Jesus to them. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. (John 13:35) Let's live out our mission statement: Love God. Live Like Jesus. Serve Others. Let's Go! And let me know if you see little Jesus around this week. It's not me ... I promise. Keep your eyes open.
